The Canon Comments 9th/10th November 2019

This weekend's Gospel reminds us clearly that God is the God of the living and not the dead.

This weekend in this country and in other countries throughout the world we mark Remembrance Weekend and the words that spring immediately to my mind are those which are recited at every Remembrance Day Service and at every Cenotaph:

> They shall not grow old, as they that are left grow old; Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn. At the going down of the sun and in the morning, We will remember them.

These words remind us of the necessity for us to remember those, military and civilian, who have given their lives for the sake of others. Each time we celebrate mass we remember also the One who gave His life that we may have eternal life.
