**The Canon Comments
12th/13th October 2019**

Those of us who are of a certain generation may well remember a sitcom of the 1960's called, "Never mind the quality feel the width". There were two main characters, one Jewish and one Irish who ran a tailoring business; it cleverly illustrated through comedy and slapstick how two people of very different backgrounds and ethnicities worked together as one, though at times enjoying a bumpy relationship!

Currently throughout the Diocese we are taking the annual mass count and what has impressed since I arrived three weeks ago has not only been the ethnic width and breadth of our four parish communities but also the quality that this gives us as functioning Catholic Communities here in our part of Lincolnshire and North Lincolnshire. All seeking to work together for the same good.

Last weekend we listened to Bishop Patrick's Pastoral Letter regarding the homeless and the responsibilities we have towards these members of our local communities. In his letter, Bishop Patrick illustrated graphically the plight of the homeless. It was gratifying to hear after the Sunday Masses of the many local initiatives that our Parishes have undertaken to help in this area of great need.

The Gospel this weekend relates the story of the healing of the Samaritan. During Our Lord's time Samaritans and Jews distrusted each other greatly. Let us pray this week that will always remain an important facet of our Christian and Catholic Faith.
