Places of Worship have not yet been given a legal obligation to display a QR code although this may change. The QR code is in addition to and will not replace the attendance records and contact details we are obliged to retain for 21 days. We have, however, been invited to support this initiative voluntarily. Our QR code is displayed in the Church entrance.

It will be a voluntary decision whether those who attend wish to use this facility.

It remains mandatory for people to supply their contact details which we are currently required to keep.

It is important to remember that this code is not to be confused with booking a place for Mass or of avoiding checking in on entry to the church. It is in addition to and does not replace the current physical attendance records we must keep.
