### Covid Update: Tier Two

From Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> October North Lincolnshire is designated as being in an Area risk level of 'High' – Tier Two. Tier Two guidance allows churches to remain open for worship provided government and Diocesan guidelines are adhered to. **Please do follow all the necessary guidelines and instructions of the stewards** – they have been put in place to ensure your safety and the safety of all in our communities.

- **It is a legal requirement to wear a face covering in places of worship.**  
You do not need to wear a face covering if you have a legitimate reason not to. This includes (but is not limited to):
  - young children under the age of 11 (Public Health England do not recommended face coverings for children under the age of 3 for health and safety reasons)
  - not being able to put on, wear or remove a face covering because of a physical or mental illness or impairment, or disability
- **When planning to come to Mass** please be aware that you may be asked to wait outside until invited in to take a seat.
- **Social distancing has been set at 2 metres**, so please observe this as you arrive and leave church and when going up to receive Holy Communion.
- **Please arrive in time** to allow for this managed arrival to take place and for Mass to start on time.
- **Hand sanitiser must be used** by everyone as they enter and leave church.
- **Singing:** The government Guidance stresses that singing is to be 'specifically avoided'.
- **Distribution of Holy Communion: Communion is to be given hand to hand only and social distancing is to be maintained with people moving within the church.**

**Please do not congregate in the Church** or outside of the Church outside of your household/support bubble group.
