Holy Souls Renovations – Further Update

Works continue to take place in and around the Presbytery at Holy Souls'. Carpets are due to be laid towards the end of this month and where necessary new blinds, curtains and electrical fittings will be fixed.

Next week works will commence to repair the Tarmac around the house and church entrance. That means for entrance to the Church for weekday mass will be via the Hall. I realise that the automatic Hall door is not working correctly, however, I have been in touch with the firm that installed it and I am awaiting a date for them to attend to this.

This past week we had a visit from Smiths of Derby, who install and maintain church bells with a view to assessing the feasibility of the bells being rung at Holy Souls' for the Angelus and Sunday Masses.

On 3 February works will commence to repair and paint and/or stain the fencing and gates around the Presbytery, also repairs and painting to the wrought iron work.

On 4 February a new boiler will be installed in the Presbytery.

Works have taken place in the house to enlarge the office, bringing it more in line with modern day requirements and it is my intention that in the near future the Parish Office of St Bernadette's and the Parish Office of Holy Souls' will be based at Holy Souls', Presbytery. This will help to reduce overheads and provide a regular presence at Holy Souls'.
