A Message from Canon Geoffrey

As you will be aware there have been several directives and instructions issued over the past few days from HM Government and The Bishops' Conference. As of 24th March 2020, for a period of three weeks, all churches will be closed to parishioners and the general public.

These are difficult times and we must follow the advice that has been given to help control the spread of this virus. Please be scrupulous in following Government guidance concerning hygiene, social distancing and self-isolation, so that we can all keep safe & keep calm. Let us pray harder than ever before for an end to this crisis

Please stay at home and only leave your home, until further notice, for one of these four reasons:

- Shopping for basic necessities, as infrequently as possible
- One form of exercise a day for example a run, walk, or cycle alone or with members of your household;
- Any medical need, to provide care or to help a vulnerable person; and
- Travelling to and from work, but only where this is absolutely necessary and cannot be done from home.

Whilst we cannot gather for Sunday Mass, Bishop's House are confident that they will be able to live stream the following liturgies from the private chapel at Bishop's House, on the Bishop's YouTube account.
