The Canon Comments
28/29 September 2019

“But he said in answer, ‘My mother and my brothers and those who hear the word of God and put it into practice.’”
Gospel of Luke, Tues, week 25 in Ordinary Time

I find this quote from Luke's Gospel quite moving and challenging. I believe it reminds us quite clearly what we are about as followers of Jesus and members of His Church – listeners and doers!

This past week has one of listening and hopeful of doing for me. I am conscience of the concerns of all four communities as we come to terms with the changes that are being introduced. May our prayer be that of the words in Luke's Gospel, that we are a people who listen to the word of God and strive to put it into practice.

Following on from the combined meeting of the four parish councils, I met with representatives of the parish councils of St Thomas', Gainsborough and St Norbert's, Crowle at Crowle on Tuesday 24th September. **It was agreed at that meeting that from SUNDAY 27TH OCTOBER 2019 (i.e., the end of British Summertime), Mass would be celebrated at St Norbert's, Crowle at 9.00am and at St Thomas', Gainsborough at 11.15am.** This arrangement would continue until beginning of BST in 2020, i.e., **29th March 2020**, when the parishes would swap the Mass times for the duration of British Summertime 2020.

Please do continue to be open to the will of The Holy Spirit and the needs of each other.
