27th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Philippians 4:6-9

This warm and affectionate little passage was probably originally the end of a letter from Paul to the community at Philippi which he loved so well. It is a lovely conclusion to a letter. Paul encourages them in every way to be cheerful in the Lord, but especially to be grateful. If we really appreciate that the Lord is near, we cannot worry and the peace of God will rest upon us. Then also gratitude and thanksgiving will be our mode of thought, penetrating all our thoughts on every subject. The word Paul uses for "thanksgiving" is the word for the Eucharist, which is the great prayer of thanksgiving offered by Christ to the Father in the name of us all. It is the summing up of all prayer, petition, gratitude and admiration. No doubt Paul is thinking of it as the high point of all prayer. **HW**

NHS Covid-19 App and the QR Code

The NHS Covid-19 App is now in operation to help support the Government Track and Trace process. Many businesses have been given a legal obligation to display a QR code in their premises to enable those who wish to use the App to 'check in' when they enter these premises.

Places of Worship have not yet been given a legal obligation to display a QR code although this may change. The QR code is *in addition to and will not replace the attendance records and contact details we are obliged to retain for 21 days.* We have, however, been invited to support this initiative voluntarily. *Our QR code is displayed in the Church entrance.* Each church and church hall will have a separate code. It will be a *voluntary decision* whether those who attend wish to use this facility.

It remains mandatory for people to supply their contact details which we are currently required to keep.

It is important to remember that this code is not to be confused with booking a place for Mass or of avoiding checking in on entry to the church. It is in addition to and does not replace the current physical attendance records we must keep.
