In order to comply with food hygiene regulations volunteers who help prepare, handle or cook food in the Parish Centre kitchen/premises which is being served at parish events now require a current certificate in Food Safety. If you have previously completed this course it is recommended that you renew the certificate every three years to keep up to date with food handling regulations.
