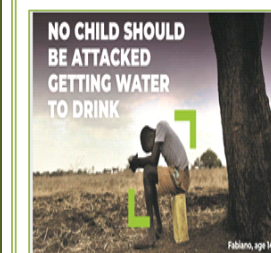
Teas and Coffees are served in the Parish Centre after Sunday Mass. Please do come along and get to know another parishioner!
