Reflection Romans 13:8-10

Paul has described the process of salvation, won for us by Christ's loving obedience to his Father. Now Paul gives his instructions how we should live as Christians; he merely slips into the basic command of Judaism: love your neighbour as yourself. Each of these negative commandments he mentions contains a clutch of positive values. If I really bond with my spouse, it will never come to adultery. "You shall not kill" implies also the values of furthering life in all the ways we can. "You shall not steal" involves also the respect for the property and well-being of others. The only debt I owe anyone is love. It is easy to kid ourselves what we are practising is love, when in fact it is self-interest, selfjustification. It is easy enough to be loving to our friends (most of the time!), but that is not what Paul means. In his earlier letter to the Corinthians he gave us that searching test for true love, "Love is always patient, never jealous, not boastful or conceited, never rude, never seeks its own advantage", and so on. I can't look many of those qualities in the face without some embarrassment. HW
