The Sunday obligation continues to be suspended, so if you are unsure about coming to Mass, do not feel under any obligation to attend. If you or someone in your household displays symptoms of Covid 19, then please stay at home.

In accordance with the Diocesan directive a 2 metre social distancing policy has been implemented in our churches. This means that only a limited number of worshippers can attend Mass and the Sacraments.

From 8th August 2020 you must wear a face covering by law in places of worship.

You do not need to wear a face covering if you have a legitimate reason not to. This includes (but is not limited to):

- young children under the age of 11 (Public Health England do not recommended face coverings for children under the age of 3 for health and safety reasons)
- not being able to put on, wear or remove a face covering because of a physical or mental illness or impairment, or disability

Reflection**

**19th Sunday in Ordinary Time
Matthew 14:22-33**

The Christian people are often depicted as a boat, with Peter at the helm. As in a boat, everyone has their part to play; kids to bring excitement and the challenge, parents to take the responsibility, grandparents just to be there to comfort and reassure. Without Jesus they were getting exhausted, frustrated and probably bad-tempered and quarrelling. When Jesus appears, everything changes; first, terror and awed amazement, then Peter rushes to meet him – and loses confidence, only to be swiftly rescued. How does Jesus come to me? In the unwelcome criticism of any angry neighbour who tells me the truth about myself? In the worries of a job or the agonies of a failed relationship? In the staggering beauty of creation? In physical pain? All these can bring God's presence, and without that presence we cannot expect to cope. Jesus does not force himself upon us. He just jogs, and says, "Here I am if you want me." He may disappear into the sea-mist again for a time, and we may sink into the water like mistrustful Peter. But it all ends with a welcome and a recognition that Jesus can cope even with a life-threatening situation. (HW)

Private Masses

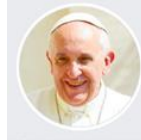
