An Introduction to Sam Hart

I would like to begin by thanking you all for the warm welcome I have received here in North Lincolnshire. I hope that during the month I am here I will not just gain experience of life in a parish, but also get to know a part of the Diocese I am less familiar with. I come from a village near Ashby de la Zouch in Leicestershire and am originally a convert to Catholicism. I studied archaeology at the University of Bristol and was involved in the excavations at Berkeley Castle. It was during my first year of study that I began attending Mass and decided to become a Catholic. After graduating I worked for a few years before beginning to explore my feeling of being called to the priesthood. I began altar serving regularly and eventually made contact with the Vocations Director for the Diocese. Eventually this led to me completing a residential year in Nottingham, living with the Vocations Director and completing placements at a local school, hospital and prison. This coincided with the first Covid outbreak and I spent the first lockdown stuck in Nottingham! When this came to an end I was interviewed by Bishop Patrick and sent to seminary in Spain for a year. This was made challenging, not just because of further Covid restrictions, but because I was now in a foreign country. I arrived back home just over a month ago with the ability to speak very bad and disjointed Spanish! In September I will start at Oscott Seminary here in the UK. I still have a long road ahead of me and will greatly appreciate your prayers, not just during my time on placement, but in the years to come.

HANDS - FACE - SPACE - VENTILATE

We ask that parishioners:

- Support NHS Test, Track and Trace by signing in with the QR code if you have a smartphone or sign and post the contact slips of paper in the post box provided.
- Sanitise your hands when entering and leaving church.
- Wear a face covering unless you are exempt from doing so for medical reasons.
- Try to leave two seats space between you and other people not in your family/social bubble
- Avoid getting too close to the person in front of you when moving to receive Holy Communion during Mass.
