Seminarian Sam's Catechism

The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

This Sunday we celebrate the Feast of the Assumption. It is the belief that the Virgin Mary, once she had come to the end of her earthly life, was taken body and soul into heaven. We find mention of this tradition back in the early days of the Church where it was known as the "Dormition" (falling asleep) by Christians living in the East. The idea being that the Virgin Mary had "fallen asleep" and her body had been raised up to heaven without seeing decay. It became a popular subject for Christian artwork and in 1950, after consultation with numerous bishops from all over the world, Pope Pius XII declared it to be official and ancient Catholic doctrine. This leads us to the question of why Mary would be taken up body and soul into heaven. It is a part of Catholic belief that she was kept free from sin during her earthly life. Therefore, although as Christians we all look forward to sharing in the resurrection of Jesus, she shared in it somewhat differently. Jesus exalted her as the Queen of Heaven, allowing her to share in his glory, and so when we look to her we anticipate our own resurrection and glory in heaven.
