The prayers for Mass and the Liturgy of the Hours within the Octave of the Nativity of The Lord refer to each day as if it were still Christmas Day. This means that, liturgically, each of the days from 25th December to 1st January is 'Christmas Day'.

To allow as many parishioners and their families the opportunity to come to Church we are asking parishioners to plan to celebrate the mystery of Christmas at *one mass only* during the Octave days.

I love You above all things and I desire You in my soul,

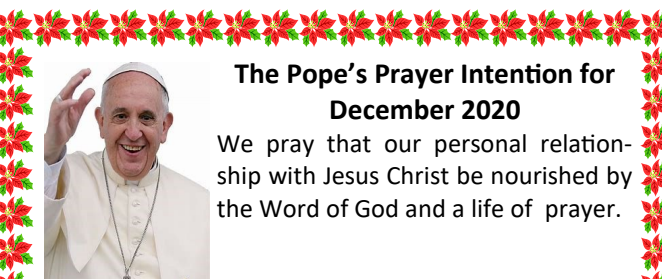
Since I now cannot receive You sacramentally,
