Day for Life ~ 19th July 2022
The Day for Life is the day each year on which the Catholi Church in Great Britain and Ireland focuses on the meaning and value of human life at every stage and in every condition. Life is to be nurtured from conception to natural death and so, this year, our Bishops are inviting us to reflect on
caring for and valuing the elderly. The COVID pandemi has highlighted the desperate plight of many older people especially those in care homes and those struggling with long-term chronic conditions such as dementia. They carried the highest burden which included prolonged isolation the distress for families being unable to visit, delayed medica interventions and tragic isolated deaths followed by shortfriends continue to bear the wound of deep grief which hurts and is still in need of healing. This year, Pope Francis has been using his weekly General Audience to offer in-depth catechesis on old age, and he has said: 'The little ones learn he power of tenderness and respect for frailty: irreplaceable lessons that are easier to impart and receive with grandpar frailty are not solely signs of decline: for young people they frailty are not solely signs of decline: for young people, they
are conditions that humanise the future.
