St Aloysius Gonzaga - 21st June

St Aloysius was a seminarian who died in Rome in 1591. He was born of an Italian noble family. At an early age he consecrated himself to God with a vow of virginity. Despite family pressure to become a soldier he entered the Society of Jesus as a young man, giving the right to inherit his father's estates to his younger brother. He went to Rome to train for the priesthood and died there, aged 23, a victim of the plague which was ravaging the city. He caught this deadly disease whilst nursing plague victims in a Roman hospital. He wrote a moving letter to his mother whilst on his deathbed, which is part of the office of readings for today. In this he explained that his death was a great blessing:

"In return for my short and feeble labours, God is calling me to eternal rest; his voice from heaven invites me to the infinite bliss I have sought so languidly, and promises me this reward for the tears I have so seldom shed."
