May the Month of Our Lady

Since the thirteenth century Catholics have dedicated the month of May to Our Lady. Some say this is because the devotion was designed to eradicate residual pagan practices. However, the actual reason is that May is the month of springtime, and Mary has brought a new springtime to the whole of creation by her role in salvation. The birth of her son has started the renewal of all things.

In May we should try to recite the Rosary daily. May crownings are also a traditional devotion. A child, usually a girl, is chosen to crown a statue of Our Lady with a crown of flowers as the culmination of a procession.

Also during this month it is traditional to make a pilgrimage to a place of Marian devotion. This need not mean a trip to somewhere far away. It could simply be to a Church dedicated to Our Lady, or to a prominent statue of the Virgin Mary in order to say a few private prayers.

In your charity please pray for

all who have died recently, may they rest in peace.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

Please pray for their families at this difficult time; for those whose anniversaries occur at this time; for all who are sick and housebound and those who have no family to support them. We remember all those who are in hospital or are having treatment, those whose treatment has been cancelled or postponed and those who are in nursing homes or being cared for.
