Canon's Catechism

What is the Old Testament?

This is the first part of the complete Bible and the Sacred Scripture of the Jews. The Old Testament of the Catholic Church is comprised of 46 books, a mixture of historical literature, prophecy, wisdom, and psalms. In the Old Testament God gradually reveals himself to mankind as creator, leader and teacher. The Old Testament also looks forward to the time of the Messiah, and prepares for His coming. Without the Old Testament we cannot truly understand the New Testament.

What is the New Testament?

This is the second part of the complete Bible. It contains the specifically Christian texts, namely the four Gospels, the Acts of the Apostles, fourteen letters written by St Paul, the seven Catholic letters and the Book of Revelation (also known as the Apocalypse). In the Gospels the person of Jesus Christ and His mission is revealed to us. The Acts of the Apostles provides us with the history of the early Church. In the letters of the New Testament the Christian way of life is presented to us. Finally the Book of Revelation looks forward to the end of time itself.

School admissions to Catholic Primary Academies

**(Reception Year) - Children born between
01/09/2019 and 31/08/2020**

The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is **15th January 2024**. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a **faith criterion** you **should also complete a supplementary information form**, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You **MUST** also include the supporting **evidence*** as required with this form, eg baptism certificate (photocopies acceptable). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place.

**If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time (NB: there may be a charge for this)*
