St Teresa of Jesus - 15th October

St Teresa of Jesus (her name in religion) died at Alba de Tomes, Salamanca, Spain, on the historic night in which the Gregorian calendar replaced the Julian calendar. As a result, though she was born on October 4th, her Feast is celebrated on October 15th. She was canonized in 1622 and named a Doctor of the Church in 1970 by Pope Paul VI. Teresa was born at Avila, Spain in 1515, of Jewish descent on her father's side. It was the golden age of Spain because of the vast amount of that precious metal which poured into the country from Latin America. As a child, Teresa was devout, and even wished martyrdom at the hands of the Moors, but during adolescence her fervor cooled somewhat and she was a worldly young girl. At the age of twenty however, she read the letters of St Jerome. These had a great effect on her, and she resolved to join the Carmelites at Avila. Shortly after her entrance she became ill, and was practically an invalid for several years. After reading St Augustine's Confessions and being deeply impressed by the image of *Ecce Homo*, a depiction of the suffering Christ, Teresa, resolved to dedicate herself seriously to the practice of prayer. She then began to work for the reform of the Carmelites, and obtained permission to found a new convent in Avila. With the help of St John of the Cross, the reform was extended also to the friars. Eventually the Holy See recognized two distinct branches of the Carmelite Order, the Discalced and the Calced. Writing from her own experience St Teresa composed three major works on prayer and mysticism: *The Life* which is her autobiography, *The Way of Perfection*, and the *Interior Castle*. During her lifetime she made more than forty new foundations of the Carmelite Nuns of Strict Observance, the Discalced Carmelites.

In your charity please pray for

all who have died recently, may they rest in peace. *Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.* Please pray for their families at this difficult time; for those whose anniversaries occur at this time; for all who are sick and housebound and those who have no family to support them. We remember all those who are in hospital or are having treatment, those whose treatment has been cancelled or postponed and those who are in nursing homes or being cared for.

School admissions to Catholic Secondary Academies (Year 7) - Children born between 01/09/2011 and 31/08/2012

The deadline for submitting your application for a school place is 31st October 2022. Application forms are available on your 'home' Local Authority website. For every Catholic school you apply for if you wish your child to be considered and ranked under a faith criterion you *must also complete a supplementary information form*, and return this form to the school by the deadline, (forms are available from the LA and the school). You MUST also include the *supporting evidence* as required eg baptism certificate (photocopies are acceptable). Failure to supply the required supporting evidence will mean your child is ranked in a lower criterion which may affect your chance of a place. If you do not have the required evidence please contact the parish where your child was baptised for a copy certificate in good time.
